

Make a Facetime Call

FaceTime is an app on iDevices that allows you to make video calls. It is also available on Mac computers. A WiFi network must be established prior to making video calls with FaceTime.

1. Set up your Apple ID and email address in Settings.



2. Select the FaceTime App

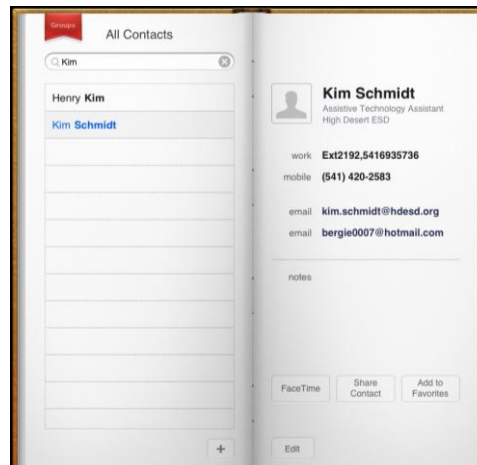


3. Turn FaceTime on. Enter your Apple ID. This is the email that you use to download Apps and Music at the iTunes Store.

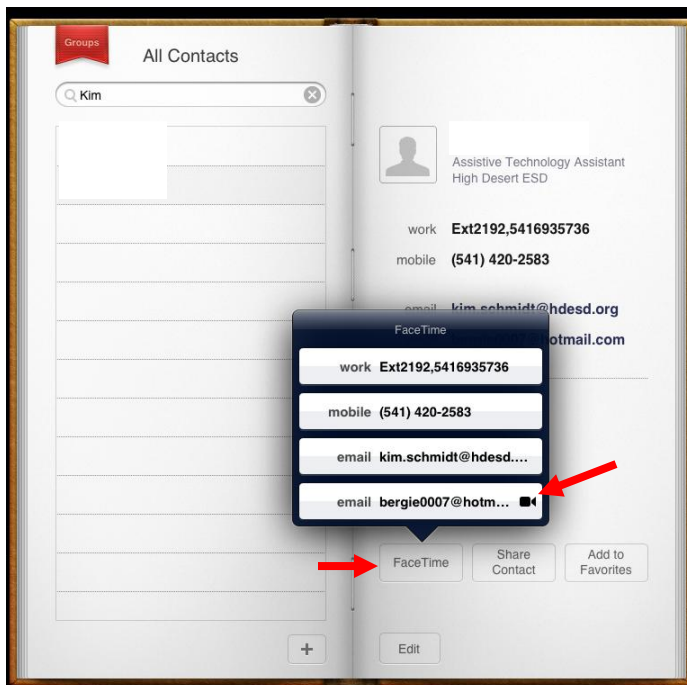


Enter an email account associated with your Apple ID. This must be done in order to make or receive calls on FaceTime.

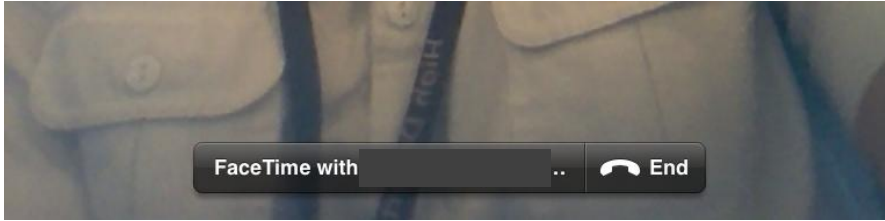
4. Enter contact information for people that you want to call on FaceTime in the "Contacts " app.



5. Select FaceTime. A camera icon identifies the email to select. If the person you wish to call using FaceTime has not set up a FaceTime account, you will not be able to call them.



6. FaceTime will open and place the call.



7. You can also place a call directly from the FaceTime app. Open the app.



8. The Contacts List allows you to choose between your Contacts list, Recent FaceTime callers, or your Favorites List. Select the name to make the call.
